**From New Jersey Turnpike (North or South)**

Turn off at Exit 9. After toll booths bear to the right; follow signs for "Route 18 North - New Brunswick." Continue along Route 18 North past the exits for "Route 27" and "Rutgers University" and proceed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge, (Approx. 3.7 miles). Get into the left lane. At the bottom of the hill (there is a traffic light) make a left onto River Road. Go straight for approximately 1.1 miles, through the traffic light. At the second light, make a right onto Hoes Lane. Go for approximately 0.4 mile to the first fork in the road – this is Frelinghuysen Road. (If you pass the UMDNJ sign, you've gone too far. ) Bear right onto Frelinghuysen Road and Waksman Parking Lot is on your left. The Waksman Institute is a colonial building with a large white clock tower. It is directly across the street from the Rutgers Golf Course.

**From Garden State Parkway (North or South)**

**Southbound - Coming from northern New Jersey**

Turn off at Exit 129 for the New Jersey Turnpike and head south. Follow directions to campus from Route 18 North, below.

**Northbound - Coming from southern New Jersey**

Turn off at Exit 105 and follow signs for Route 18 North. After approximately 24 miles you will pass the entrance for the New Jersey Turnpike and continue on Route 18 North. Proceed on Route 18 North past the exits for "Route 27" and "Rutgers University" and proceed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge, (Approx. 3.7 miles). See below.

### **From Route 1 (North or South)**

Turn off at exit marked "Route 18 North-New Brunswick". Proceed on Route 18 North past the exits for "Route 27" and "Rutgers University" and proceed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge, (Approx. 3.7 miles). Get into the left lane. At the bottom of the hill (there is a traffic light) make a left onto River Road. Go straight for approximately 1.1 miles, through the traffic light. At the second light, make a right onto Hoes Lane. Go for approximately 0.4 mile to the first fork in the road – this is Frelinghuysen Road. (If you pass the UMDNJ sign, you've gone too far. ) Bear right onto Frelinghuysen Road and Waksman Parking Lot is on your left. ### **From Route 287 (North or South)**

Turn off at Exit 9 (Formerly Exit 5) "River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park." Proceed east on River Road toward Highland Park until you reach the third traffic light (approximately 3.0 miles) at the intersection of River Road and Hoes Lane. Turn left at this traffic light onto Hoes Lane. Go for approximately 0.4 mile to the first fork in the road – this is Frelinghuysen Road. (If you pass the UMDNJ sign, you've gone too far. ) Bear right onto Frelinghuysen Road and Waksman Parking Lot is on your left. The Waksman Institute is a colonial building with a large white clock tower. It is directly across the street from the Rutgers Golf Course.
